As we read the Scriptures, we see that God progressively reveals His character in the many compound names of Jehovah. Today as I was personally worshipping God, I considered the story of Israel's test early on in the wilderness wanderings. Following the crossing of the Red Sea, Moses leads them into the Desert of Shur where they traveled for three days without finding water. When they finally found water it was undrinkable. They named the place Marah, meaning bitter. While the Israelites complained, Moses prayed and God showed him what to do. He cast a piece of wood into the water and the water immediately became fit to drink. After God "healed" the water, He reveals himself to them with a new name. In Exodus 15:26, we read "If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice

of the Lord thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes. I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee." That last phrase, "I am the LORD that healeth thee," is the name Jehovah-Rapha. We are in desperate need of a healer of our sins. Just as God provided a tree that healed the waters of Marah, He has also provided a tree on which Jesus died to heal our sin. While the main reason for Jesus coming was to heal our sins (Luke 19:10), He also worked miracles of physical healing as a testimony of His power over disease. In Galilee, Jesus, the Great Physician, went from town to town, "healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people." (Matthew 4:23) It is right for us to pray to God for physical healing. Sometimes it is not His will to heal (2 Corinthians 12:7-9), but often it is, if we pray (James 5:13-16).

Most of us know of people right now who are struggling with major illnesses. We have several dear friends who are battling cancer. There are two pastors that I preached for in the past few months that have been seriously ill with COVID-19. We are also praying for one of our major donors who is in critical condition fighting for his life. As I have messaged with friends and family, I have expressed how grateful I am that our God is sovereign and that He is always good. As we hear of more and more people getting sick and we pray, let us remember that God is Jehovah-Rapha, "the God who heals."
