At EMU International, our purpose statement has been widely published: The Purpose of EMU International is to bring glory to God by assisting churches and individuals in carrying out the Great Commission given to the Church Universal by our Lord Jesus Christ through (1) ministries of evangelism, (2) establishing indigenous churches, (3) and equipping nationals to do the same.

Underlying the three areas of focus above is our ultimate goal, "bring glory to God." One of my favorite Psalms is Psalm 96. Verse 3 gives the command for us to "Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples!" Literally all the people groups of the world. That is our passion at EMU, to declare His glory among the nations. As director that is my mission, but that is YOUR mission too. While evangelism is a huge part of Umissions, our task is not primarily soteriological, it is doxological. Missions is all about the glory of God.

In preparing for an upcoming workshop that I will present at a Christian college, I found myself in Isaiah chapter 6, a very familiar passage. In these verses, we read where Isaiah, after seeing his sinfulness and declaring, "Woe is me," then surrenders his entire life to God's mission by expressing, "Here am I Lord, send me." Before all of that, he had to see the Lord, high and lifted up. He is given a glimpse into the throne room of the universe and beholds an incredible sight. He describes the Seraphim who are even today worshipping God on His throne. They cry out in verse 3, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!" I was struck by that last phrase. Read it again. Is that some kind of exaggeration, particularly when we consider all of the bad things happening in our world today? Is this true when wildfires sweep across Maui, where more than 100 people died in the deadliest U.S. wildfire in over a century? Or what about when a hurricane slams into Florida and then carves a path of destruction and flooding across Georgia and the Carolinas resulting in an estimated financial loss of \$20 billion? Is the whole earth really full of his glory? In this time of global pandemics, political unrest, racial tensions, wars, and rumors of wars, mark it down, God is doing something.
