October was another busy, but enjoyable month as flights had me touching down in Dallas, Des Moines, Chicago, Pittsburgh, and Philadelphia. God blessed as I had the privilege of sharing the ministry of EMU International and preaching in South Carolina, Maryland, Pennsylvania, North Carolina, and West Virginia. It was a joy to reconnect with students at Faith Baptist Bible College in Ankeny, Iowa, and to fellowship with other leaders of missionary agencies. I am extremely grateful to the families who hosted me this past month. At the church in West Virginia, I was asked to preach about the family and connect it to missions. God gave me great liberty as I preached a two-part message entitled, "Nurturing a Culture of Missions in Your Home." I introduced the message by looking back at the year 1727 in Germany, specifically at the Moravian community, one of the oldest Protestant denominations. It was around this time that the church as a whole began an extended season of fasting and prayer, a prayer meeting that is said to have lasted twenty-four hours per day, seven days a week for 100 years. The modern missions movement can trace its origins to this lengthy commitment to prayer. How in the world did they maintain that kind of interest and commitment? The surprising answer: involve the children. Start with the adults, and then the children. One historian said, "All the children were seized with an extraordinary impulse of the Spirit and spent the whole night in prayer. No words can express the powerful operation of the Holy Spirit upon these children, whose lives were so transformed." Every hour of the day, intercession was made for the nations. This was a family affair that resulted in parents passing a love for missions on to their children. It resulted in multigenerational faithfulness that lasted an entire century.

As we finish up the month of November, by God's grace, we will gather with loved ones and friends to celebrate Thanksgiving. Invite your children to join you at the "big table," not the little card table in the corner. Remind them of God's goodness. *O give thanks unto the Lord; for he is good; for his mercy endureth forever. (1 Chronicles 16:34)*
