I hold in my hands this morning souvenirs from forty years ago, a folded map, and tickets dated July 29 and 30, 1984, to events held in Los Angeles for the Games of the XXIII Olympiad. My father and uncle flew to California to witness the spectacle that is the modern Olympic games. My dad saved the tickets and I found them in a box last week. This got me thinking of the excitement that has been building since April 16, when on the eve before 100 days to go, the Olympic flame, a symbol of peace and hope, was lit. This year, the Olympics will be held in Paris, the home of EMU missionaries Tim and Ruth Bixby. When I visited France in December, I witnessed the excitement and anticipation as construction was taking place to accommodate the estimated 15 million visitors to Paris, including two million from abroad. The opening ceremonies will be held on Friday, July 26. Instead of being held in a traditional stadium, the ceremonies will take the form of a 4-mile-long floating procession down the Seine River. Live coverage of the ceremony begins on Friday, July 26, at noon EST.

In 1896, the inaugural modern Olympics unfolded in Athens, Greece, with 280 participants (all male) representing 13 nations. that competed in 43 events. Fast-forward to the 2024 Paris Olympics, where over 10,500 athletes from 206 countries will compete in 32 sports and 45 total disciplines within them. Interestingly, it wasn't until the VIII Games in Paris (one hundred years ago in 1924) that the Olympics truly soared as

an international sporting spectacle. The motto in Latin is "Citius, Altius, Fortius - Communiter" and in French: "Plus vite, Plus haut, Plus fort - Ensemble." When translated into English, it means, "Faster, Higher, Stronger - Together."

In the New Testament Epistles, we find rich athletic metaphors that encourage believers to live out their faith with the same dedication and discipline as an Olympic athlete. For example, 1 Corinthians 9:24-25, Philippians 3:13-14, Hebrews 12, and I Corinthians 15:50-58. These verses emphasize perseverance, discipline, and the pursuit of eternal rewards. Just as athletes train and compete with determination, Christians are called to run the race of faith with unwavering commitment. Certainly, we are to pass the baton to the next generation and let the flame of our light shine brightly. For those of us who know the Lord, we know that true peace and hope cannot be attained through an Olympic flame or athletic competition, but only through Jesus Christ.

It also must be said that the Olympic motto, "Faster, Higher, Stronger - Together," applies to our task as Christians to take the gospel message to every tongue, tribe, and nation. We are truly stronger when we work together. On behalf of all of us here with EMU International, I want to thank you for being a part of our team.
