

Director, EMU International TIME FLIES

Schools in Greenville County South Carolina began on August 1. I'm sure students all over town are asking the same question, "Where did our summer go?" Yesterday, July 31, was my birthday. As I get older, I find myself wondering why time seems to pass faster and faster.

I discussed this subject last week with a pastor friend in Alabama as I ministered in his church with the **Crnković** family, our Croatian missionaries who are in the States for six weeks. We discovered that there are several reasons for this strange phenomenon. It's a mix of biology, psychology, and perception. According to a study at Harvard University, one theory says that as we age, our brains process information more slowly, meaning we perceive fewer mental images in a given period, making time seem to pass more quickly. The pastor mentioned the concept that was addressed in an article by Psychology Today, that tries to explain the phenomenon. When you're five years old, a year is 20% of your life. But when you're 50, a year is only 2% of your life. This proportional difference makes each

Since we only had an evening plus one full day of sightseeing, we walked around 50,000 steps during our time in the Big Apple. Since then, they have ministered in Connecticut, Indiana, Ohio, Alabama, and South Carolina. They also enjoyed touring the Ark Encounter. The first week of August they will be in the Greenville, SC, area. They are staying at the Morningside Baptist Church mission house.
