Greetings from Campamento Emanuel in Guazuvirá, Uruguay! It is with great joy and gratitude that I write to you, reflecting on a wonderful week of fellowship and training with our dedicated national workers. Accompanying me on this trip has been Bill Hill, director of Equipping Nationals Worldwide. This marks his fifteenth trip to Uruguay, where he continues to enrich our workers with his wisdom and experience.

The theme for our sessions this week was "Let Us Encourage Each Another." Bill and I each spoke five times, aiming not to position ourselves as authorities with all the answers but as colaborers, united in our effort to strengthen one another. It was a humbling and inspiring experience to see God's hand at work in the lives and ministries of our workers. I had the privilege of conducting one-on-one interviews with each of them, and I was greatly encouraged by the stories of God's grace in their families and their churches. Though ministry for all of us can be difficult at times, God's sustaining grace and providential hand are clearly at work. Please pray for these faithful servants.

The weather was quite warm, with temperatures soaring into the 80s and 90s. Fortunately, we had a bit of a respite with some rain and cooler temperatures over the past couple of days.

On Sunday, Bill and I will each be speaking at different churches, and we eagerly anticipate starting Family Camp on Monday with over 60 campers in attendance. Bill will speak on Monday before heading back to the USA, while I will continue to preach for the remaining eight sessions and at a couple of other churches next Sunday.







My upcoming messages will focus on "Your Missionary Family," a theme that I am passionate about. I am scheduled to return to Greenville on Monday evening, March 10, and will arrive home on Tuesday afternoon, March 11. After a few days at home, I will travel to Michigan on Saturday, March 15, to speak at Calvary Baptist Church in Midland for their Missions Conference (March 16-19), followed by a Missions Emphasis Sunday at Childs Bible Church in Onondaga the following week. I will finish the month in Frederick, Maryland, with another Missions Emphasis Sunday at Peoples Baptist Church. I am excited to share the ministry of EMU International and speak on the theme of "Your Missionary Family" with these congregations as well.

On behalf of all of us at EMU International, I want to thank you for your unwavering prayers and financial support. Your partnership is invaluable to the work we are doing. We are deeply grateful for your faithful commitment to our ministry.
